#### 2023 USRowing Southeast Youth Championships

Fifteen NORC Juniors competed at the Southeast Youth Championships this year in Gainesville, Georgia. Two-thirds of our boats advanced out of time trials and two qualified for Youth Nationals! Congratulations to Audrey, Bethany, Lola, Ava, and Hayden for taking 2nd in the Women's U17 4+ and Fifi for placing 4th in the

Women's U17 1x. The team's hard work showed with their 7th place ranking for the Efficiency Trophy out of 41 teams.



#### 2023 USRowing Youth National Championships

After regionals it was straight into more training for Fifi, Audrey, Bethany, Lola, Ava, and Hayden to prep for Youth Nationals. These rowers traveled to Sarasota, Florida, in early June to compete on the national stage. They performed admirably through four grueling days of competition, finishing 12th in the Women's U17 1x (Fifi) and 21st Women's U17 4+.



2023 USRowing Southeast Masters Championships

NORC's Masters team had major successes at the Southeast Masters Championships in June with nineteen rowers bringing home a total of four gold, two silver, and nine bronze medals from Aiken, South Carolina.



#### Two Juniors Attend Olympic Development Camp
